Education & Science Sector Experience;

Sawtry Infant, Junior and Pre-schools – a multi-phased development, creating a two class base pre-school, six new classrooms, and an extension to the existing school hall.

Buxhall Farm Primary School – Working with alongside RG Carter and multiple stakeholders to design a new £8.5m Primary and Pre- School in a sensitive Green Belt location on the edge of Cambridge.

Whittle Laboratory – Complex redevelopment project, for the University of Cambridge, creating high bay spaces for large scale experiments and testing, including wind tunnel rigs for aeronautical engineering research.
