



### HE & Science Sector Experience;

**Coslet Building Extension and New Entrance** – £1m Project for Anglia Ruskin University in Cambridge, to create an enlarged Café, new entrance and student space for an existing 1960's teaching building.

**Project Hadar**– £15m refurbishment of an existing city centre research building for the University of Cambridge. The project provide research space for the Toxicology Unit and joins two existing buildings together creating shared spaces designed to promote scientific collaboration.

**Scarsdale Veterinary Hospital**– New Small Animal Veterinary teaching hospital for the Scarsdale Veterinary Group and University of Nottingham in Derby

**University Library Off-site Storage Facility**– this project for University of Cambridge is a Storage facility for low-use but unique printed material providing over 100,000 metres of shelving in a fully conditioned environment.

**School of Veterinary Medicine and Science** – the University of Nottingham created what became only the seventh Vets School in the UK at their Sutton Bonnington Campus.

**Cambridge Centre for Imaging**– £10m remodelling of existing building to create specialist imaging research facility for the University of Cambridge.
